Task

In pairs, you are to use the StoryVisualizer software to make a presentation of a myth or legend of your choice using at least 6 scenes. As you create you are to journal the process you worked through when making decisions as you create, store and test your content. You also need to include in your journal how you worked with others and effectively communicated your ideas.

Step One:

Choose a myth or legend. It can be from your culture or another. Once you have selected one, check in with your teacher. Create a digital journal (Google Doc) in your Digitech folder.

Step Two:

Plan how you are going to portray your myth or legend.

- How many scenes will you need?
- What characters will feature?
- What is/are the setting/s?
- What camera shots and angles will you use?
- What effects will use utilise on StoryVisualizer?

In your journal sketch out a rough plan. Check in with your teacher.

Step Three:

Begin developing and building your scenes for your photos. As you create your content make notes in your journal about changes you made to your original plans. Make sure you store your photos in appropriately.

Step Four:

Import your photos in to StoryVisualizer and create your storyboard. Again, as you complete this step make sure to note in your journal any problems that you needed to solve and how you solved them.

Step Five:

Save your storyboard as a png and submit it and your journal to your teacher via Google Classroom.
